English

We have started reading 'Egyptian Cinderella' and will be using this as a stimulus for our writing. We will write a diary entry from the perspective of one of the book's characters. We will focus on elements such as writing in the first person and the past tense.



Reading

Each class will have Reading lessons where we focus on key skills. We will work on children's recognition of new vocabulary, their understanding of themes and characters and their ability to summarise sections of stories concisely.

Please encourage your child to read with an adult every day and record in their reading diary. Where possible, ask your child questions to develop their understanding. For example, what does this word mean? Why has the character done that? How is the character feeling? How do you know? Can you summarise that paragraph? What do you think will happen next?

Please ensure that your child comes to school each day with their reading book and reading record

Maths

We will be building on our knowledge of Place Value and Number this term, focussing on addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Children will be learning how to add and subtract 3-digit numbers in a column. Children must still have a firm grasp of number bonds and times tables so we'll be doing plenty of games and activities to promote this. As we move through Year Three, we hope to develop each child's independent thinking and reasoning skills, furthering their problem-solving ability.

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Maths - how can you help?

Please encourage your child to learn their number facts (+ and - to 20) and times tables. Se-

curing these number facts will enable them to (concentrate on learning new mathematical processes.

By the end of year 3 children should be able to rapidly recall their 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 8x and 10x tables. Please practise telling the time too! This year, children need to learn to tell the time to the nearest minute.

Progress

The school is working hard to ensure that all children make good rates of progress. It is important that children understand what they are learning and how to improve. Please discuss this with your child and encourage him/her to tell you what they enjoy doing in class.
