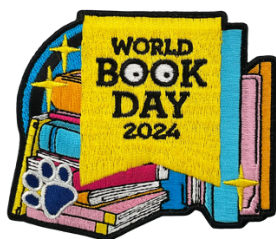
Welcome note

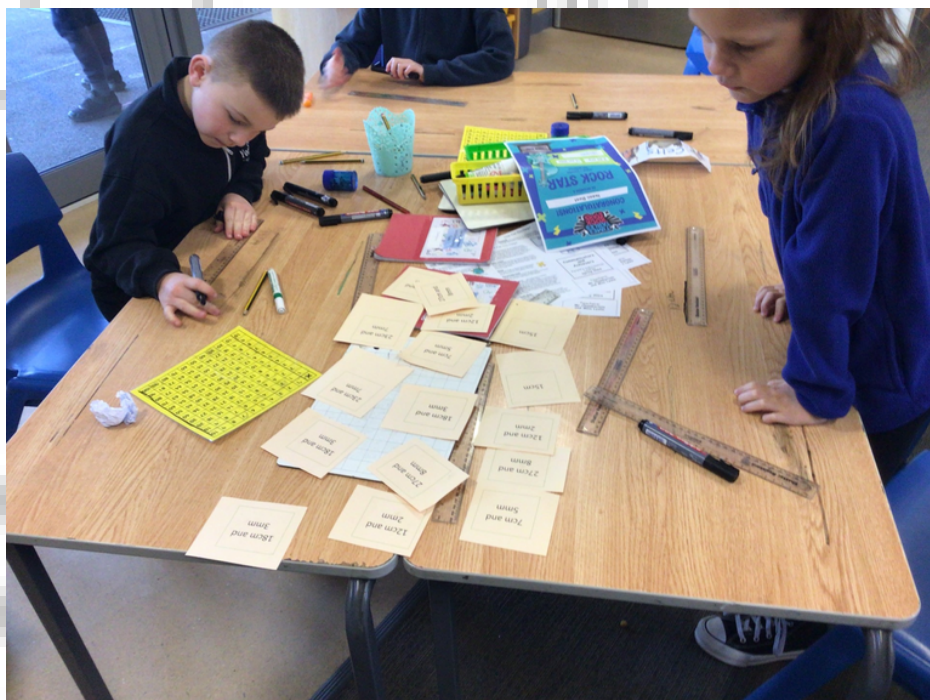
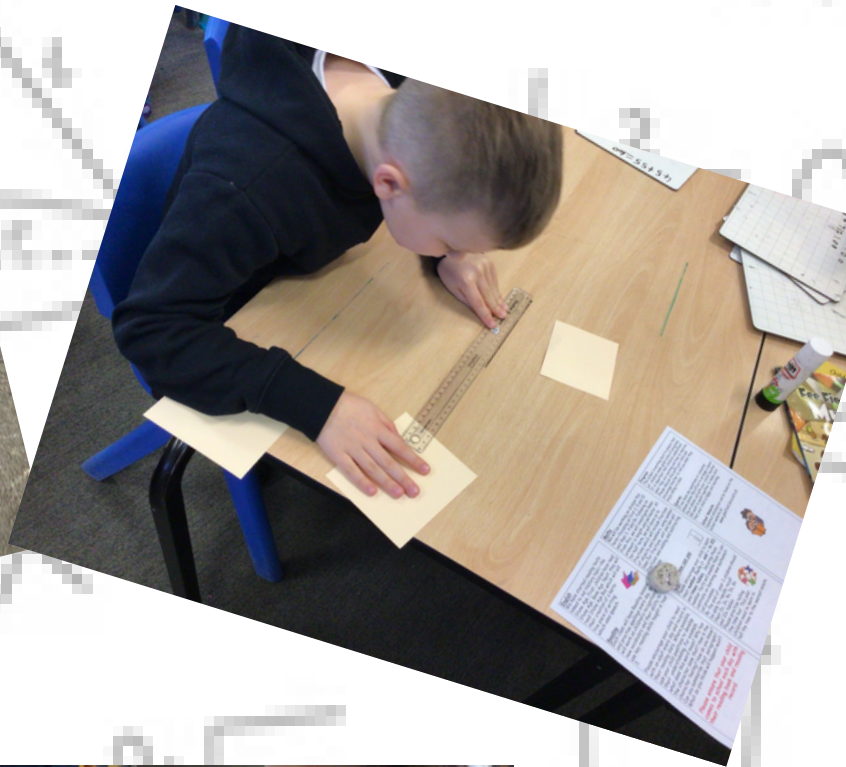

Tuesday 6th February 2024 is Safer Internet Day. This year's theme is 'Inspiring change? Making a difference, managing influence, and navigating change online'.

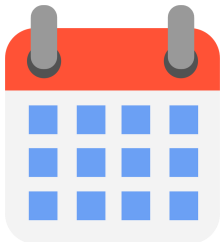
The East Midlands Specialist Operation Unit (cybercrime) are offering a free webinar for parents on Tuesday 6th February at 7pm.
