Staffing news

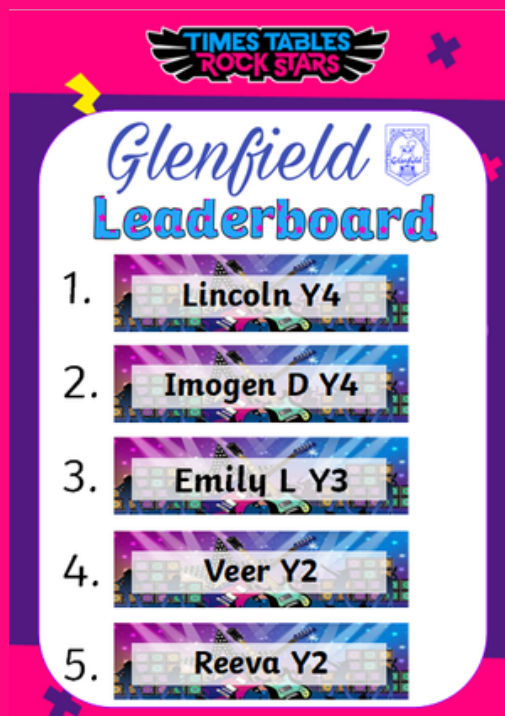
