# **English**

We will be looking at the texts The Butterfly Lion and How To Live Forever. We will use these texts to produce non-chronological reports, biographies, letters and narratives.

Reading

Each class will have a reading lesson every day. We will work on children's recognition of new vocabulary, their understanding of themes and characters and their ability to summarise sections of story concisely. We will work on a variety of skills, including vocabulary, inference and predicting.

Please encourage your child to read aloud with an adult every day and record this in their reading diary. Where possible, please ask your child questions to develop their understanding. For example, what does this word mean? Why has the character done that? How is the character feeling? How do you know? Can you summarise that paragraph? What do you think will happen next?

# Maths

This term in Maths we will be working on shape, fractions, time, money and statistics. We will continue with regular times tables tests—by the end of the Year 3 we expect the children to be confident reciting the 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

# Maths - how can you help?

Please encourage your child to improve their rapid recall of multiplication and division facts for the above times tables.

Please practise telling the time too! This year, children need to learn to tell the time to the nearest minute.



## **Progress**

The school is working hard to ensure that all children make good rates of progress. It is important that children understand what they are learning and how to improve. Please discuss this with your child and encourage them to tell you what they enjoy learning in class.
